All WSI members who have paid 2008 membership dues may register ONE watermedia painting for exhibition. **All paintings must be registered in our office by May 29, 2009.** Non-registered paintings will NOT be accepted at the One America building. All paintings executed and presented in accordance with the rules will be exhibited unless, in the opinion of the Exhibitions Committee or OneAmerica, subject matter may be viewed as objectionable by the general public. Paintings exhibited in prior juried shows ARE eligible. **PAINTINGS MUST BE FOR SALE.** Call the WSI office (317-814-6194 x 150) with questions.

DELIVERY OF PAINTINGS TO One America ON JUNE 6th

Between 10 am and noon, artists may drop off paintings at OneAmerica: Drive through Kissing Road on the north side of the building (off New York which is one-way EAST). WSI volunteers take your paintings from the registration table to the atrium for hanging. Artists may then park in the surface lot across New York Street and return to the building to register their painting. **Parking on June 6th is paid by WSI.** Enter the parking lot from Illinois Street (one-way NORTH); enter the lot to your left as you traveling north on Illinois. There is no entry to the lot from New York Street. We have requested that the “arm” on the lot be up by 9:30 a.m.

RULES

1. A minimum of seventy-five percent (75%) of the entry must be watercolor or acrylic material. If desired, the balance of the entry may be pastel, charcoal, ink and collage (e.g. photos, computer art, fabric, metal foil, etc.). The decision of the Exhibitions Committee is final in accordance with these rules. Because "wall" space is limited, overall frame size is limited to 32" x 40" or less.
2. Work must be matted and framed under glass or plexiglass. All work must be ready to hang with flat hangers and wire (No sawtooth hangers). No damaged or warped frames will be accepted. Plexiglass is preferred in metal frames larger than 18x24. The overall look of the show is better with neutral mats.
3. All paintings must be the original work of the artist. No copies of paintings or published photographs may be entered. In the event of duplicate paintings, neither painting will be exhibited.
4. A label with the artist name, painting title and painting price must be attached to the back side of the painting.
5. Entry title and price MAY NOT be changed after forms have been submitted.
6. The Watercolor Society of Indiana will take a 30% commission on all sales.

SALES

- ◆ **Paintings must be for sale.** The painting price should include a 30% commission to WSI. All sales will be conducted through the WSI office. A check, less the 30% commission, will be forwarded to the artist within 30 days.
- ◆ **Sold Paintings may be taken immediately by the buyer. The artist will be notified and given the opportunity to hang another painting at no additional fee.**
- ◆ Artists agree to furnish their social security number to the WSI office upon request if sale is \$600 gross or more. WSI must report to the IRS all sales or awards totaling \$600 or more during the year for any individual artist.

DELIVERY OR PICK-UP ASSISTANCE

You will be charged \$25 each way if the office provides transportation. If you need assistance with delivery of your painting on June 6th or with pick up of your painting on June 26th, contact the WSI Area Representative for your region of the state. If you live in Indianapolis and need help, please call an artist friend.

SHIPPING

If shipping a painting, it should be crated and delivered to the WSI office by Fri. May 28. The WSI office will return an unsold paintings in the same crate it arrived in. The artist must set up an account with FedEx or UPS so that all shipping costs will be paid by the artist. There will be a \$25 charge for transporting your painting to and from downtown.

RISK

The Watercolor Society of Indiana will exercise diligent and reasonable care, but neither WSI nor One America will be responsible for loss or damage to any painting. By participating in the show, the artist assumes all risk and agrees to the rules and conditions of this prospectus. Artists may not remove paintings from the show prior to the afternoon of Friday, June 26th. If your painting is sold, you will be given the opportunity to hang another painting.

UNCLAIMED PAINTINGS

Unclaimed paintings will be returned to the WSI office. **There is a \$25 charge for transporting a painting back to the WSI office after the exhibit.** We will hold it until 12/29/09 at which time it will become the property of WSI.
