

Explore Landscapes and Greens with Dale Popovich, IWS

This two day workshop is divided as follows:

Session 1: Demonstration. This will be a step by step 2.5 hour workshop on ZOOM stopping between steps and answering questions along the way. The photos of each step will be provided to the attendees. The recorded video will be sent to the attendees following the first session. The video will be available for 6 weeks following the critique.

Session 2: ZOOM Group Critique. Following part 1, students will be encouraged to paint on their own. Students will email or upload finish paintings to Dale for review. During the critique the students paintings will be shared online with the group. Dale will walk through each painting and answer additional questions. Key learning strategies will be discussed throughout the process and emphasized as the critique concludes.


